



## ADVENTURE TOURISM TOURIST DECALOGUE

## Before purchasing an adventure tourism activity, keep the following in mind:

- Make sure the tour operator is registered at: serviciosturisticos.sernatur.cl
- Remember that guides must provide a **briefing** before the activity begins
- Every adventure tourism activity must have one or more guides to accompany and supervise you.
- Risk Acceptance Form at the start of the activity. For minors, this form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- Check if the company provides **accident insurance** for participants.

- Demand that the company provide equipment in **good condition**.
- You have the right to check the **Activity Sheet**, the **Risk Management Plan**, and the **Emergency Plan** before starting the activity.
- Find out about **age limits** and **requirements** you must meet before participating in an activity.

If you have a disability or reduced mobility,

- check that you can access tourist information. Inclusive companies offer blind participants objects or 3D replicas, audio guides, and/or QR codes compatible with screen readers. For deaf participants, they provide visual information about the activity or a sign language interpreter.
- If you have a disability or reduced mobility, make sure to receive clear instructions and ask the guide about the warning signals that will be used: these may include light alarms, sound alarms, flags, or signs, among others.
